

Amendment to HALO's By-Laws--Descriptions of Districts Adopted May 6, 2010

Abbott Loop District (District 1)— Bounded on the west by the New Seward Highway, on the north by Dowling Road as extended generally east to Birch/Boniface, on the east by Birch/Boniface, and on the south by O'Malley Road.

Abbott and Upper O'Malley District (District 2)— Bounded on the west by Birch/Boniface, on the north by Dowling Road as extended east to the South Fork of Campbell Creek and along it to Chugach State Park, on the south by Huffman/Upper Huffman Road as extended east to Chugach State Park, and on the east by Chugach State Park.

Lower Hillside District (District 3)— Bounded on the west by the New Seward Highway, on the north by O'Malley Road, on the east by Birch Road and North Goldenview Drive, and on the south by Rabbit Creek Road.

Upper Huffman District (District 4)— Bounded on the west by Birch Road and North Goldenview Drive, on the north by Huffman/Upper Huffman Road as extended to Chugach State Park, on the east by Chugach State Park and on the south by Rabbit Creek Road from Goldenview Drive to its intersection with Mountain Air Drive then south, following the western boundary of Bear Valley Community Council, which is generally south along Hillside Drive as extended, and diagonally through Section 12 of Township 11 North, Range 3 West and Section 18 of Township 11 North, Range 2 West to Chugach State Park. This District shall include the area of the Bear Valley Community Council and the Glen Alps Community Council as they existed on January 1, 2008.

Rabbit Creek District (District 5)— Bounded on the west by the New Seward Highway from Rabbit Creek Road south to Potter Creek, on the north by Rabbit Creek Road to its intersection with Mt Air Dr, on the east from Mountain Air Drive south along the western boundary of the Bear Valley Community Council (as it existed on January 1, 2008), which is generally along Hillside Drive as extended, and diagonally through Section 12 of Township 11 North, Range 3 West and Section 18 of Township 11 North, Range 2 West to Chugach State Park, and on the south along the Chugach State Park boundary westward to Potter Creek at the New Seward Highway.

Basher (District 6)—Section 6 of Township 12 North, Range 2 West, generally within the Basher Community Council area.

District 6 shall be served by a single representative from the community of Basher who either owns/rents a home or owns land within the Basher area and shall be elected every other year at the annual meeting of the members for a term of two years, as further provided by the Board of Directors.

Each of the other foregoing district representatives shall either own/rent a home or own land within the district they represent, and shall be elected to Seat A or Seat B within that district for staggered terms of two years at the annual meeting of the members. Seat A Directors shall be elected in even numbered years and Seat B Directors elected in odd numbered years.
