

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF INITIATING A
HILLSIDE ROAD, DRAINAGE AND TRAIL SERVICE AREA (HRDTSA)
AS RECOMMENDED IN THE HILLSIDE DISTRICT PLAN

WHEREAS The Hillside District Plan makes the following recommendation:

14-A. Establish a new Hillside Management Entity to manage and finance roads, drainage, built-green infrastructure watershed protection and aquifer recharge; and trails at a watershed and/or community-wide scale.

WHEREAS Establishing the entity requires a vote of Hillside residents in the new Service Area and the Hillside District Plan calls this the “highest priority.”

WHEREAS The Hillside District Plan assigns to the HRDTSA responsibility for these goals:

9-A. Identify proposed future road connections to improve the system of primary and secondary roads within the Hillside District.

9-C. Prioritize maintenance and upgrades on primary and secondary roads, placing emphasis on projects that address existing safety and efficiency concerns, including making optimum use of existing infrastructure and supporting efficient growth patterns.

9-E The road management entity (locally controlled by Hillside residents) will have the responsibility to track and coordinate with plans by ADOT&PF and the MOA Traffic Department, including prioritizing future funding requests

12-D. Develop maintenance, repair and schedule priorities for roads and trails.

WHEREAS the problems these goals address continue to concern residents of the Hillside.

WHEREAS the process for forming the HRDTSA may take several years.

THEREFORE:

HALO requests that the Anchorage Assembly appoint Hillside residents to an organizing group for the purpose of creating a Hillside Road, Drainage and Trail Service Area as recommended by the Hillside District Plan.

Passed by the board of the Hillside’s Home And Landowners Organization, Inc. (HALO) on October 6, 2011.
